BASIC FUNCTION

Assembles, installs, and repairs pipes, fittings, and fixtures of heating, water, and drainage systems, according to specifications and plumbing codes. General maintenance and grounds.

NATURE & SCOPE

Reporting to the Director of Facilities, this position is responsible for routine maintenance and as needed repairs on the plumbing systems in order to ensure that they continue to function properly. General maintenance and grounds

PRINCIPLE ACCOUNTABILITES

- Assembles and installs valves, pipe fittings, and pipes composed of metals, such as iron, steel, brass, and lead, and nonmetals, such as glass, vitrified clay, and plastic, using hand tools and power tools.
- Joins pipes by use of screws, bolts, fittings, solder, plastic solvent, and caulks joints.
- Installs and repairs plumbing fixtures, such as sinks, commodes, bathtubs, water heaters, hot water tanks, garbage disposal units, dishwashers, and water softeners.

SPECIALIZED KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE REQUIRED

This position requires two years of college or vocation/technical school.
