

Transient Students

The Financial Aid Department will assist degree seeking Savannah State University students in receiving financial aid while participating in study as a transient student. Transient study refers to a degree-seeking Savannah State University student attending another United States college or university (referred to as host institution). To be reviewed for federal financial aid as a transient student **you must** complete all of the following requirements below:

Please Note: if you tell us you will be transient and you decide **NOT** to go transient then you **MUST** let us know. Failure to do so will result in a delay of **ANY** financial aid.

Savannah State University students attending another Title IV eligible U.S. Institution must understand and complete the following:

1. Receive an approved [Transient/Letter of Good Standing](#) from Savannah State's Registrar's Office.
2. Be enrolled in a degree or other recognized credential program at Savannah State University.
3. Submit the [Financial Aid Consortium Agreement](#) to the Host School for completion of Section II.
4. Return the completed form along with a copy of the transient approval letter to the Financial Aid Office.
5. Take courses at the Host School, as approved by the Registrar's Office at Savannah State University.
6. Pay all tuition, fees, and other charges at the Host School according to their payment schedule. Aid is disbursed according to Savannah State University's disbursement schedule.
7. Immediately notify Savannah State University's Financial Aid Office of any changes in enrollment status at the Host School, including withdrawing from all courses or substitution of approved courses.
8. Maintain the Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy which is posted on the Savannah State University Office of Financial Aid website.
9. Ensure that the Host School submits an academic transcript to Savannah State University upon completion of the consortium agreement period.

Some institutions may not be willing to complete a consortium agreement and Savannah State University cannot release any funds. You should check with the host institution prior to attending.
